

“EINAP” Association of Hospital Doctors of Athens and Piraeus

In the Prosfygika Complex on Alexandras Avenue, approximately 400 people have been living for more than a decade. Among them are many vulnerable individuals: sick people, elderly people, and families with children.

In recent months, they have been firmly resisting the Regional Authority’s decision to proceed with the “redevelopment” of the area. This site is not only a refuge that has provided housing to families for decades since the 1930s, but it is also one of the few remaining buildings bearing traces of the battles of December 1944.

The community of Prosfygika is fighting for the right to housing and survival. The implementation of the Atticas Regional Authority’s plans will force all these people onto the streets.

Among them are two individuals, Aristotelis Chatzis and Suzon Doppagne, who are on hunger strike. The first has been on hunger strike for 110 days, and the second for 25 days. Their health and lives—especially that of Aristotelis Chatzis—are in serious danger.

We call on the competent authorities to suspend all such plans and not throw 400 people out onto the street.
